1. Free baggage allowance size restrictions, by weight: The length, width and height of each standard checked baggage item must not exceed 100 cm (40 in), 60 cm (24 in) and 40 cm (16 in) respectively.

By piece: The linear dimensions of each standard checked baggage item must be at least 60 cm (24 in) and shall not exceed 158 cm (62 in). **Overweight, oversized or excess** baggage is subject to excess baggage fees (see Appendix 3).

2. Weight requirements for standard checked baggage: **Domestic carriage** The maximum weight of each piece of checked baggage shall not exceed 45 kg. **International carriage** Each piece of checked baggage normally shall not exceed 32 kg. Baggage items weighing between 32 kg and 45 kg must meet the relevant regulations of the destination airport and onward carrier.

3. Checked baggage piece limit: There is no maximum limit on the number of checked baggage items per passenger (including standard and special baggage). Passengers needing to check in seven or more extra pieces of baggage in excess of the free baggage allowance and PhoenixMiles membership allowance (including standard and special baggage) must request permission from an Air China sales office/airport desk in advance. Please note that said extra baggage will be accepted only if space is available on the aircraft. At the same time, Air China does not guarantee that said extra baggage will be transported on the same flight as the passenger. All sales offices/airport desks are requested to ensure that this information is communicated to passengers.

4. Actual free baggage allowances are as displayed in the GDS (Global Distribution System).
